

MEDALLION HUNT RULES

1. **Must have a button to participate.**
2. Clues will be handed out daily at the Champlin Speedway (100 Miller Rd).
3. The first clue will be distributed the Monday of the festival week.
4. No digging, climbing or destroying property. **NO metal detectors allowed.**
5. The medallion wouldn't be hidden inside any building.
6. The medallion will only be hidden on City of Champlin Properties. **The medallion will never be hidden at the Cemetery or Dunning School.**
7. Clues will only be available for one day only. Previous days clues **will not** be available after original publication.
8. Anyone can participate in the medallion hunt **except** City of Champlin employees, Speedway employees or family members of these groups.
9. If the medallion has not been turned in by 9:00 a.m. on the Monday immediately following the festival completion, the City of Champlin reserves the right to terminate the hunt and turn the prize over to charity.
10. Once found, the medallion must be brought to city offices (11955 Champlin Drive) during business hours Monday - Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. After hours and on weekends, call 763-923-7193 to notify. The winner will receive a prize in the form of a check.
